The new position would teach several courses in different majors such as The Bachelor degrees programs in Early Years Education, Primary Education, Secondary Education and The Expert Course and the Master programs in Education Leadership.

RESPONSIBILITIES/JOB SUMMARY: As director of the master program, you will have direct responsibility for the administrative and academic management of the program. Also, Faculty members at UCJC should teach, carry out their own research agenda and provide administrative services to the department and faculties they work with.

Applicants should have expertise in formal teaching for undergraduate programmes, but may also be required to provide formal teaching for postgraduate programmes; ensure active involvement in research in international education and globalization; act as a supervisor for graduate and postgraduate students; and research in critical analysis, intercultural communication, leadership, teamwork and problem-solving. Must be committed to undergraduate education and must be able to teach any subject in the above-mentioned areas. The teaching load will be flexible according to the academic and professional profile of the candidate and institutional needs. UCJC is committed to

prioritizing the career development and skill leverage of its faculty. The successful candidate will have a strong commitment to students and learning at a liberal arts and sciences university. Service responsibilities include student advising, mentoring, and taking an active role in curriculum design. All faculty members at UCJC are committed to perform a certain amount of administrative tasks such as assisting in the courses coordination or representing the university in national and international forums.
