Candidates for tenured Associate and Full should have international reputations, expertise, and distinguished records in terms of scholarship, applied experience, external leadership, and university service. They should demonstrate a capacity and willingness for academic and professional entrepreneurship and innovation. Candidates must be able to meet the requirements of tenure at Thunderbird and Arizona State University.

Formal application must be accomplished through submission of 1) a cover letter that addresses how you meet the qualifications and why you are interested in this position at Thunderbird/ASU; 2) a curriculum vitae (including a list of manuscripts under review identifying the journal and review status); 3) a research statement; 4) a teaching statement with any evidence of teaching competency/teaching evaluations (if available); 5) a statement (one page maximum) addressing how your past and/or potential contributions to diversity and inclusion will advance the Thunderbird School’s commitment to inclusive excellence; and 6) a list of three (3) references, all uploaded through <https://apply.interfolio.com/84091>.
