Company Description:

Founded in 1919, AUC moved to a new 260-acre state-of-the-art campus in New Cairo in 2008. The Department of Economics has anticipated openings for faculty positions at the level of Assistant/Associate/Professor for a fixed term four years appointment, to begin in Fall 2022. Strong practical quantitative and research methodology skills will also be highly valued.
