#### **Position and Environment**

The House of Innovation (HOI) at the Stockholm School of Economics (SSE) currently invites applications for an Associate Professor or Assistant Professor position with a focus on Entrepreneurship.

Candidates are expected to have strong qualities in both research and teaching. In research, the successful candidate should exhibit the ability to publish in top-tier, peer-reviewed, international journals, as evidenced by a promising research and publication pipeline, a presence in the international research community, and publications in leading journals (if available). In teaching, experience from designing and delivering courses, as well as from coaching student projects, is considered a merit. Candidates will be expected to interact and collaborate with faculty from other disciplines and to exercise intellectual leadership in their discipline.

The position is tenured or tenure track depending on experience and qualifications. The tenure track is a three- plus three-year position, with promotion to tenured associate professor subject to satisfactory research and teaching performance.

This year, we are particularly interested in (but not limited to) candidates with a research orientation fitting with our newly formed Center for Family Enterprise, under the leadership of Professor Mattias Nordqvist. We encourage interested candidates to think broadly about how their research fits or might fit with the broader topic of family enterprise and family-based venturing.

An ideal starting date for successful applicants is August 2023, but we are open to discussing other dates. Salaries are competitive, commensurate with qualifications and experience, and are set on an individual basis.
