Candidates will also need to demonstrate their strive for excellence, their growing reputation in the field as well as their innovative and inspiring scholarship approach. The successful applicant will have a flexible attitude and the ability to adapt to any circumstance, by consulting and liaising confidently with senior-level stakeholders. Demonstrable experience in liaising with external bodies, both nationally and internationally, ensuring compliance with numerous frameworks and policies is also highly desirable. In addition to the criteria at Associate Professor's level, to be appointed at Professor level (ALEVE), candidates need to demonstrate international leadership in the Accounting discipline with a reputation of being a recognised expert in the field; relevant service on editorial boards of top-tier international journals (ABDC A/A*) across the Accounting discipline; a track record of substantial external research funding with successful project completion and impactful outcomes; relevant experience of building national and international research teams as well as mentoring junior academics in the discipline.
